Summer To Do List

Reading - Recite the sounds in the alphabet frequently. Practice decoding and sounding out words. Read independently for 20-30 minutes a day then discuss what happened at the beginning, middle, and end of each story. Discuss story elements (characters, setting, plot, etc.) after each story.

Language - Practice writing first and last name capitalizing correct letters. Practice appropriately-sized, neat and legible handwriting on notebook/wide ruled paper only please. Practice writing complete sentences with punctuation. Practice writing neat paragraphs about any topic (5 sentences or more please). Spell various sight words 5-10 minutes a day (the, then, where, when, why, because, every, circle, person, those).

Math - Review simple addition math facts for 10-20 minutes a day. Review simple subtraction math facts for 20-30 minutes a day. Practice/review counting by 2's, 5's, and 10's. Discuss elements of time (specifically time by the hour-- 1:00, 2:00, etc.). Discuss money (which coins are which, how much they are each worth) and review this frequently.

Reading- Read 15 to 20 minutes with your child 5 out of 7 days. Talk about the story and who the characters are, their challenges, and how they overcome them.

Math skills for addition/ and subtraction: word problems, unknowns in any position, two-digit and three-digit numbers, stories involving comparison of two numbers.

Language Arts: Encourage writing of grocery lists, notes to people, paragraphs of 5 or more sentences.
